

OUR FOCUS

The acronym BAM imitates the sound of a hard blow or conveys the abruptness of an occurrence. In a world where development, growth and improvement are a constant occurrence, there is a compelling need to upgrade outmoded norms and techniques of service delivery with modern ideas that would not only promote our ideals but radically position the Lions Club for national and global recognition/continuous improvement.

We will focus on the following:

BRANDING, IDENTITY AND COMMUNICATION

 We will redesign our website to be userfriendly, interactive, and functional. We will communicate with our members and prospects through email newsletters.

 We will set up a creative committee to vet all Lion's Club's communication/media

materials before publication.

 We will create an award-worthy documentary about Lions Clubs in Nigeria.

 We will collaborate with prominent media houses to promote the Lions Club's activities and for other PR purposes.

• We will increase social media participation by creating and curating ideas and content that will increase audience engagement.

 Provide quality branding materials, scarves, car stickers, pens, etc.

- Collaborate and engage corporate bodies and government agencies to plan their CSR activities.
- Participate in the formulation of government policies regarding NGO operations.

ADMINISTRATIVE STRUCTURE

 To encourage effectiveness, we shall encourage effective zone to clubs communication

 The reporting hierarchy will be restructured for effective communication and service proficiency.

MEMBERSHIP

• We will employ strategic means to increase membership organically.

- We will prioritize the welfare of members through medical and mental health seminars/reorientation, checkups, empowerment programs, and insurance (HMO, life, etc.)
- Periodic town hall meetings will be held with all members.
- Regular training with short videos, quizzes, seminars, and webinars.

BETTERING OUR SERVICE

INNOVATION – Extensive innovations will be implemented in three core areas. They are:

- **1.BUSINESS VENTURES:** The business venture funds will be accessible by both Lions and Leos and will only be approved by the central committee after due diligence has been carried out from the submission of proposals and proper documentation.
- 5 million Business Venture Funds for Lions (maximum of 500,000 per individual)
- 2 million Business Venture Funds for Leos (maximum of 200,000 per individual)
- 2. SERVICE ACTIVITIES: There shall be well coordinated District quarterly medical mission and there will be District Club support of at most 100,000 naira for Clubs in the form of Grants to carry out service activities within the global causes. Clubs can only apply for the Grant once in the Lions Service Year.

We will also employ the following means to increase the effectiveness of our service to the community.

- We will encourage clubs to carry out occasional service activities to spread our reach across the board.
- We will critically analyze regular requests for clubs to key into district activities before approval.
- We will ensure that clubs send their monthly service activities plans for the year at the beginning of the lion's year.
- The district will partner with clubs to encourage more activities.
- Audit all the existing district projects and produce a status report.

Encourage clubs to apply for grants.

- Encourage and provide resources to encourage and promote progressive innovation and ideas.
- 3.CORE PROJECT: "Sharing hope per meal." The core project for the year is building and equipping a food bank in Ikeja and making it accessible to the less privileged. As one of the global causes is hunger relief, the aim is to help people in the community who cannot afford to feed daily, the mission is to establish a community free from hunger and tackle malnutrition, especially in children. The food bank will also nutrition advice and counselling to people. The establishment of the food bank is to address food insecurity in Lagos. This project will give access to healthy food, which can improve people's health and reduce healthcare costs as well as aid in good healthy living.

DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION

- 1.The DG Team: The DG team consists of the District Governor, the First Vice District Governor, and the Second Vice District Governor. The essence of this team is to foster efficiency, collaboration, innovations, and support. I shall involve my team in all areas of district administration to ensure the smooth management of the district and to share vision, goals, and direction.
- 2.District Structure and Cabinet: We shall operate the Lions International District Cabinet Structure which incorporates the Global Action Team. We have redistributed the and Zones for administration. we have also carefully selected experienced and versatile Lions as Cabinet Officers which comprises Committee Chairpersons, Zone Chairpersons, Region Chairpersons and Core Officers
- 3.Global Action Team (GAT): The Global Action Team consists of the Global Extension Team (GET), Global Membership Team (GMT), Global Leadership Team (GLT) and Global Service Team (GST). The concept of the GAT is to envision a day where every need in the world can be served by a Lion and Leo.

Our team shall work tirelessly to bring about change infusing innovation into our programs in order to a lasting impact at the Clubs and District levels.

MEMBERSHIP GROWTH, RETENTION AND RECRUITMENT

- 1.GLOBAL EXTENSION TEAM Commits to the organization-wide goals and objectives of MISSION 1.5, which includes achieving defined regional membership targets.
- Develops, supports and executes an annual membership growth plan in support of MISSION 1.5 in collaboration with the district Global Action Team (GAT).
- Adheres to an annual engagement calendar developed by the district GAT chairperson (district governor) to monitor progress towards MISSION 1.5 regional targets, including participating in monthly check ins with GAT area leaders and multiple district leadership, and monthly check ins with district GAT and zone and region chairpersons.
- Monitors club chartering reports, tracks and interprets data and forecasts results.
- Implements strategies and provides ongoing motivation and training to support the district in achieving their MISSION 1.5 goals in relation to membership growth and extension.

- Identifies opportunities to charter new clubs in communities or within groups of a larger community that are not served or are underserved.
- Collaborates with district leadership to build a team capable of completing the tasks required in successful chartering of new clubs including membership recruitment, leadership development, and engagement in meaningful service projects.
- Develops a plan and timeline for each potential new club following proven processes for new club development including developing a team, site research, needs assessments, identification of sponsoring clubs and guiding lions, informational and organizational meetings, and charter member recruitment.
- Collaborates with district GAT coordinators and the district GAT chairperson to maintain effective communication across all levels of GAT via multiple channels such as in-person visits, newsletters, correspondence, social media, etc.
- Partners with district GAT leadership to conduct relevant MISSION 1.5seminars, events, and projects at Council and Cabinet meetings, district convention and other local meetings.
- Understands and communicates the process and policies of new club development to team members and ensures that accurate information is conveyed to prospective members. Rev. 7/1/2023
- Enables the success of new clubs by helping sponsor clubs establish mentoring relationships with the new club officers and educating Guiding Lions on expectations of the new club.
- Provides training and support to Lions interested in new club chartering to expand the district's ability to charter new clubs in support of MISSION 1.5.
- Ensure new club applications are complete, properly approved, and submitted efficiently.
- Promotes completion of the Global Membership Approach training path andshares best practices.
- 2.GLOBAL MEMBERSHIP APPROACH –
 Energetic and proud members are very important to the success of any service year, A Global membership team has been put in place to support membership development, recruitment of new members as well and enhancing positive membership experience. The Membership Goal from 2023 to 2027 is to grow the global membership to 1.5 million

The Global Membership Approach equips districts to develop membership through a strategic process focused on:

- Rejuvenating districts with new clubs
- Revitalizing clubs with new members
- Re-motivating existing members with fellowship and exciting service

The approach has universal applicability, allowing for customization based on regional needs and circumstances, and is supported by a growing collection of material resources.

The Global membership approach has four processes that have been in use over time to increase both satisfaction and new member recruitment. The four steps are:

- Build a Team.
- Create a vision.
- · Design a plan.
- · Execute it successfully.

SERVICE PROGRAMME (GLOBAL SERVICE TEAM)

The Global Service Team shall work closely with the Clubs to make sure that impactful projects are carried out within the global causes and most importantly reported. There shall be incentives for Clubs that follow the guidelines and procedures.

GLOBAL CAUSES



Diabetes: Diabetes is one of the global Causes of Lions International. We serve to reduce the widespread of diabetes and improve the quality of life for those diagnosed. We will work with dietitians and nutritionists to create budget-friendly meal plans that will help them manage the disease properly.



Hunger Relief: In a world where people live on less than \$1 per day, Organizations such as Lions International serve to ensure all community members have access to nutritious foods. This led to the vision of creating a food bank to assist people who earn below the average income – "Sharing hope per meal".



Vision: Lions International is well known for the deliberate efforts we put in to improve the vision of the people in our community. We are Knights of the Blind because we serve to prevent avoidable blindness and improve the quality of life for people who are blind and visually impaired.



Environment: In the last Service year, the International President Dr Patti Hill, launched a campaign tagged "Lions go Green. We will ensure the sustainable protection of our communities by designing an eco-friendly project that will protect our seas, trees, mammals, and environments.



Pediatric Cancer: We serve to help children affected by pediatric cancer survive and thrive. We will embark on several awareness activities across the districts to provide support for this cause. Leos and Lions will work hand in hand to carry out impactful projects this lion service year.



Youth Development: This was just recently added to our Causes. Since we have our Youth Activity (The LEO Club) we shall make a deliberate effort to improve their programs and organize summits and seminars towards building a better future for the Community and the Association.



Humanitarian: Humanitarian is a global Cause despite just being recently added to our causes as being part of parcel of the club. Our mission is to make the world a better place worth living in by making service to humanity our priority. We shall abide by the slogan that says 'Where there is a need; there is a Lion.



Disaster Relief: Lions International has been giving relief materials to victims who have been displaced by Disaster in the past. Even though no one is praying for a natural disaster, it is also not a predictable occurrence. We shall work hand in hand with the Nigerian Lions Charity Foundation to provide relief materials in cases of flood and other natural disasters.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT AND CAPACITY BUILDING

Leadership development is the outcome of capacity building. The essence of capacity building is to help our members manifest in their official roles and personal life while also exposing them to tools needed for continuous self-development. With trainings, orientations, and resources, we will build each member into a leader with deep insights, management ability and effective team-bonding leadership skills. We believe this will help us grow as a club and inspire personal development. Our aim is not groom these leaders development of the club, but to also enable them to participate with fine moral principles in politics, policy making, and community development. Here are some benefits of leadership development that we are intentional about:

Retention of members: By investing in leadership training throughout the district, members can be retained and there will be a reduction in loss of membership at the end of the service year.

Increase Service Activities: the right and consistent leadership can increase the productivity of our members. This is so because leadership development brings about understanding the emotions of both members being led, and the society being served.

Make Better Decisions: leadership training will result in better decision-making because leaders functioning at a high level of emotional intelligence tend to make informed and intelligent leadership decisions.

Nurture Future Leaders: quality leadership is a combination of the right qualities and the right training. We realized that leadership roles are often given to the most forward candidates with dominant personalities. 




